Facilitating Questions

In ST Math[®], the puzzles start off simple and then get more challenging as the student progresses. When they reach a challenging problem, they may ask for your help.

To help them, ask questions like:

- What do you notice about the puzzle?
- What do you think you have to do to solve the puzzle?
- What things can you click on?
- Describe the strategy that you are going to use.
- What do you expect to happen when you try your strategy?
- Describe what you see after you try your strategy. Was it what you expected?
- What did you learn?
- How will you use what you learned?

If your child continues to be stuck and does not know what to do, have them play a previous level. Ask, "What did you learn from the previous level that can help you in this new level?"
