INEFFECTIVE

- Learning relies solely on memorization
- Learning experience has no social context
- Students are penalized for making mistakes

DEVELOPING

- Conceptual connections are made when learning the schema
- Learning experience involves interactions with others
- Mistakes have no consequences on the learning

HIGHLY EFFECTIVE

- Students build a deep understanding for how and why the schema works, allowing them to derive the concepts
- Learning experience has meaningful social elements, such as collaboration and cooperation
- Early mistakes are learning opportunities. Environment guides students away from repeatedly making the same mistakes.
