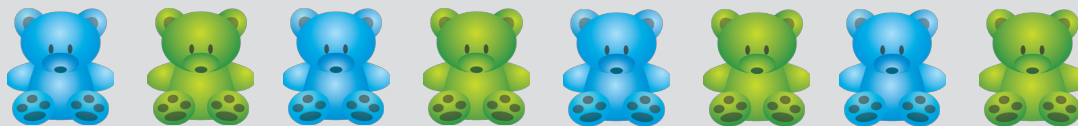


AB Patterning with J-i-J-i

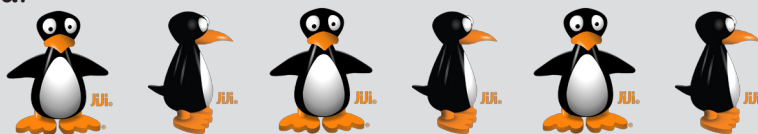


What is a pattern?

A pattern is a set of objects or numbers that are related according to a rule. One simple type of pattern is a sequence of repeating units. We can categorize this type of pattern by an abbreviation that describes the length and configuration of the repeating unit. For example:



The repeating unit is two distinct elements (A = 'blue' and B = 'green'). Similarly, an ABB pattern would have a repeating unit of length three, one element repeated once and another element repeated twice. Let's explore AB patterns with JiJi!
