

SHOOT FOR THE STARS Bulletin Board


Measure out 60 vertical inches of butcher paper and hang up in a place where your staff can view your school's progress throughout the year.

Print and cut out percentage stars to create percentage brackets, Astronaut JiJi to act as a moveable percentage gauge, and the bulletin board title.

Paste your title letters at the top of the bulletin board and percentage stars vertically along the butcher paper. SHOOT 20% FOR THE STARS

Stick a velcro strip on the bulletin board in a vertical line and a square of velcro on the back of the rocketship to create a moveable path for Astronaut JiJi so you can update your school's progress throughout the school year!

Optional:

Place velcro strips horizontally between each percentage bracket. Then put velcro squares on back of star shape cut-outs and write in teacher and grade names to represent individual class progress.
